Looking for After-Hours Access?

As a WestEdge member, you have more access to your money than ever before at no cost. Look and see what works best for you:

- Night Drop Deposit checks and cash in our secure Night Drop on the north side of our building. Simply fill out one of the envelopes provided, drop it in, and let us take care of the rest. Night Drop is processed Monday - Friday at 9am on regular business days.
- 2. Remote Deposit One of the great benefits of our Mobile App is the ability to deposit checks from anywhere. No need to come by or use a stamp; just sign your name on the back, write "WestEdge Mobile Deposit" and take a picture in our Mobile App. Visit westedgeCU.org/rdc to learn more.
- **3.ATM** WestEdge members can access over 30,000 CO-OP® network ATMs across the country. Whatcom County has about 40 ATM locations, with a dozen or so accepting cash and check deposits. Find ATMs near you at **westedgeCU.org/atm**.
- **4. Shared Branching –** Also on the CO-OP network are other credit union branches you can visit and conduct transactions on your WestEdge account. Your nearest Shared Branching location can be found at **westedgeCU.org/sharedbranch**.
- 5. BillPay With Online Banking, you can check your accounts 24/7 and pay your bills through our BillPay service. Enjoy the convenience of managing all your bills in one place... for free! Learn about all the benefits and get started at westedgeCU.org/billpay.
- 6. Person-to-Person Payments Send funds to anyone, anywhere, and in real-time with Person-to-Person (P2P) payments on our Mobile App. All you need is their name and either their phone number or email address to send them funds. Learn more at westedgeCU.org/p2p.
