A new core system is coming September 2 – and it means better service, stronger security, and enables us to offer our members new products and services in the future.

This fall, WestEdge Credit Union will be upgrading our core data processing system – the foundation that powers every transaction, every account, and every service we provide to you each day. This is one of the most significant investments we have made in years, and we are making it for one reason: to serve you better.

This core system upgrade is an important technological advancement for the credit union and for you as it promises improved security, enhanced services, and greater banking convenience. It will be more robust, more modern, and more capable than our current system. It also opens the door to new products and services in the future. This is part of our continued focus on investing in and supporting our members.

What You Need to Know About the Transition

To complete the upgrade, **WestEdge Credit Union will be CLOSED on Tuesday, September 1, 2026.** All systems – including in-person services, online banking, and our mobile app – will be temporarily offline that day. We know your time is valuable, and we appreciate your patience as we make this one-day investment in your financial future.

We are happy to report that **the go-live date for the new system is Wednesday, September 2, 2026.**
